A+ should monitor Grand Imports' pricing closely and ensure its rates remain within \$10–\$15 to prevent price-sensitive customers migrating.

RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

Top 5 Moves for A+ Japanese Auto Prioritized by competitive impact and urgency

Recommended Actions — Week of March 31, 2026

- 1 Audit Grand Imports' online presence** — they have the same Japanese make positioning. Check their Google rating, review volume, and service pages weekly. Know when they add new services or shift pricing. **HIGH PRIORITY**
- 2 Market next-day availability explicitly** — Genuine Automotive is consistently booked 1–2 weeks out. A+'s fastest path to new customers is capturing overflow. Add "Same-week appointments available" to Google Business Profile and website here. **HIGH PRIORITY**
- 3 Position A+ on Japanese make expertise vs. Firestone's generic offering** — create a landing page or Google Business Profile section highlighting Toyota/Honda/Honda service. Use language like "Toyota-certified technicians" and "Honda factory-equipment diagnostics." **HIGH PRIORITY**
- 4 Review pricing on brake service and alignments** — A+ is competitively priced vs. Firestone and Advanced but 10–15% below Genuine and Grand Imports. Consider a slight increase on alignment (\$95–\$110) to match Grand Imports' rate while still undercutting Genuine. **MEDIUM**

PRIORITY

- 5 Add a "Why Choose a Specialist?" comparison block to A+'s website — directly contrast A+'s Japanese make focus against Firestone/Advanced (generalist) and Christian Brothers (premium). A clear comparison page converts search traffic into appointments.
